These resources have enabled organizations and providers to adopt and implement innovative interventions that bridge gaps in prevention, treatment, and care across the HIV Care Continuum. They also address the social determinants driving HIV among historically marginalized populations disproportionately impacted by the epidemic: people from racial and ethnic minority groups, LGBTQ+ individuals, people with substance use disorders, and justice-involved persons.
